Genesis 1:3

3 Then God Said, "Let there be Light"; and there was Light.

Isaiah 7:14

14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a Sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His Name Immanuel.

Isaiah 9:6-7

6 For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is Given, and the Government will be upon His shoulder and His Name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

7 Of the increase of His Government and Peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His Kingdom, to order it and establish it with Judgment and Justice from that time forward, even forever.

The zeal of the Lord of hosts will Perform this.

Isaiah 11:1-5

1 There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots.

2 The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.

3 His delight is in the fear of the Lord, and He shall not judge by the sight of His Eyes, nor decide by the hearing of His Ears;

4 But with Righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His Mouth, and with the Breath of His Lips He shall slay the wicked.

5 Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins, and Faithfulness the belt of His waist.

Isaiah 40:8

8 The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of our God stands forever."

Isaiah 42:1-7

1 "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My Soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth Justice to the gentiles.

2 He will not cry out, nor raise His Voice, nor cause His Voice to be heard in the street.

3 A bruised reed He will not break, and smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth Justice for Truth.

4 He will not fail nor be discouraged, till He has established Justice in the earth;

5 Thus Says God the Lord, Who Created the Heavens and stretched them out, Who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, Who gives breath to the people on it, and spirit to those who walk on it:

6 "I, the Lord, have Called You in Righteousness, and will hold Your Hand; I will keep You and give You as a Covenant to the people, as a Light to the gentiles,

7 To open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house.

Isaiah 50:5-6

5 The Lord God has opened My Ear; and I was not rebellious, nor did I turn away.

6 I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My Face from shame and spitting.

Isaiah 52:13-15

13 Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be Exalted and Extolled and be very high.

14 Just as many were astonished at you, so His visage was marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men;

15 So shall He sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; For what had not been told them they shall see, and what they had not heard they shall consider.

Isaiah 53:3-8, 10-12

3 He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

4 Surely, He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His Mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His Mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living;

For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

10 Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall See His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand.

11 He shall See the Labor of His Soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My Righteous Servant shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities.

12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the Great, and He shall divide the spoil with the Strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made Intercession for the transgressors.

Isaiah 61:1-3

1 "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has Anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has Sent Me to Heal the brokenhearted, to Proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

2 To Proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn,

3 to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."

Daniel 2:44

44 In the days of these kings the God of Heaven will set up a Kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the Kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of Heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him.

14 Then to Him was given Dominion and Glory and a Kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His Dominion is an Everlasting Dominion, which shall not pass away, and His Kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed.

Zechariah 9:9-10

9 'Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is Just and having Salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.

10 He shall Speak Peace to the nations; His Dominion shall be 'from sea to sea, and from the river to the ends of the earth.'

Zechariah 12:10

10 'I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn'.

Luke 1:30-33

30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.

32 He will be Great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the Throne of David.

33 And He will Reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His Kingdom there will be no end."

Matthew 1:20-21

20 An angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.

21 And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Luke 2:8-14

8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night.

9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the Glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid.

10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.

11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

12 And this will be the Sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."

13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the Heavenly host praising God and saying:

14 "Glory to God in the Highest, and on earth Peace, Goodwill toward men!"

Matthew 2:1-2

1 After Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem,

2 saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."

Luke 2:28, 30-32, 42-43, 46, 49

27 When Mary and Joseph brought the Child Jesus into the temple,

28 Simeon took Him up in his arms and blessed God and said:

30 "My eyes have seen Your Salvation

31 Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples,

32 Light to bring Revelation to the gentiles, and the Glory of Your people Israel."

42 When He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast.

43 When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it;

46 Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.

49 And He Said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?"

John 1:1-5, 9-18

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2 He was in the beginning with God.

3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

4 In Him was Life, and the Life was the Light of men.

5 And the Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

9 That was the true Light which gives Light to every man coming into the world.

10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His Name:

13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 And the Word became Flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth.

15 John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "

16 And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace.

17 For the law was given through Moses, but Grace and Truth came through Jesus Christ.

18 No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

John 1:29-34

29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

30 This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.'

31 I did not know Him; but that He should be Revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water."

32 And John bore witness, saying, "I saw the Spirit descending from Heaven like a dove, and He remained upon Him.

33 I did not know Him, but He who Sent me to baptize with water Said to me, 'Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who Baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'

34 And I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God."

Matthew 3:13-15

13 Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him.

14 And John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me?"

15 But Jesus answered and Said to him, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all Righteousness."

Luke 3:21

21 It came to pass that Jesus was baptized; and while He Prayed, the Heaven was Opened. 22 And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a Voice came from Heaven which Said, "You are My Beloved Son; in You I Am Well Pleased."

Luke 4:16-19, 21

16 Jesus went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.

17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

18 "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has Anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor;

He has Sent Me to Heal the brokenhearted, to Proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed;

19 To Proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."

21 And He began to Say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

Matthew 5:17

17 I did not come to destroy but to Fulfill.

Luke 6:12-13

12 It came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to Pray, and continued all night in Prayer to God.

13 And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles:

Mark 2:5, 10-11

5 When Jesus Saw their Faith, He Said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are Forgiven you."

And Said: 9 Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'?

10 But that you may know that the Son of Man has Power on earth to Forgive sins"--He Said to the paralytic,

11 I Say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."

John 4:14

14 Jesus answered and Said, "Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into Everlasting Life."

John 4:32, 34

32 He Said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know."

34 "My food is to do the Will of Him who sent Me, and to Finish His Work.

Luke 4:43

43 He Said to them, "I must preach the Kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been Sent."

Luke 19:10

10 for the Son of Man has come to Seek and to Save that which was lost."

John 5:17, 19-24, 26, 30, 37

17 Jesus Answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working."

19 Jesus answered and Said to them, "Most assuredly, I Say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He Sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

20 For the Father Loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel.

21 For as the Father raises the dead and gives Life to them, even so the Son gives Life to whom He Will.

22 For the Father judges no one, but has committed all Judgment to the Son,
23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father.
He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who Sent Him.
24 "Most assuredly, I Say to you, he who hears My Word and believes in Him
who sent Me has Everlasting Life, and shall not come into judgment, but has
passed from death into Life.
26 For as the Father has Life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have
Life in Himself,

30 I can of Myself do nothing. As I Hear, I judge; and My Judgment is Righteous,
because I do not seek My own will but the Will of the Father who Sent Me.
37 And the Father Himself, who Sent Me, has Testified of Me. You have
neither heard His Voice at any time, nor seen His Form.

Matt 8:24, 26

24 Suddenly a great tempest arose on the sea, so that the boat was covered with
the waves. But He was asleep.
26 Jesus Said to the disciples, "Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?"
Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm.

John 6:5-6, 8-13

5 Jesus lifted up His eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him,
He Said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?"
6 But this He Said to test him, for He Himself Knew what He would do.
8 One of His disciples said to Him,
9 "There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what
are they among so many?"
10 Then Jesus Said, "Make the people sit down." So the men sat down, in
number about five thousand.
11 And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had Given Thanks He
distributed them to the disciples, and the disciples to those sitting down; and
likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted.
12 So when they were filled, He Said to His disciples, "Gather up the fragments
that remain, so that nothing is lost."
13 Therefore they gathered them up, and filled twelve baskets with the
fragments of the five barley loaves which were left over by those who had eaten.

Matt 14: 23-25, 27-29

23 When He had sent the multitudes away, He went up on the mountain by
Himself to Pray. Now when evening came, He was alone there.
24 But the boat with the disciples was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by
the waves, for the wind was contrary.

25 Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea.
27 Immediately Jesus Spoke to them, saying, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not
be afraid."
28 And Peter answered Him and said, "Lord, if it is You, command me to
come to You on the water."
29 So He Said, "Come."

John 6:35, 38, 51, 53-58

35 Jesus Said to them, "I am the Bread of Life. He who comes to Me shall
never hunger, and he who Believes (Knows) in Me shall never thirst.
38 For I have come down from Heaven, not to do My own will, but the Will of
Him who Sent Me.
51 I Am the Living Bread which came down from Heaven. If anyone eats of
this Bread, he will Live forever; and the Bread that I shall give is My Flesh,
which I shall give for the Life of the world."
53 Then Jesus Said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the
Flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood, you have no Life in you.
54 Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood has Eternal Life, and I will
raise him up at the last day.
55 For My Flesh is food indeed, and My Blood is drink indeed.
56 He who eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood abides in Me, and I in him.
57 As the Living Father Sent Me, and I Live because of the Father, so he who
feeds on Me will Live because of Me.
58 This is the Bread which came down from Heaven—not as your fathers ate
the manna, and are dead. He who eats this Bread will Live forever."

Matt 11:29-30

29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I Am gentle and lowly in
heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
30 For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Mark 9:37

37 "Whoever receives one of these little children in My Name receives Me;
and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me."

Luke 8:21

21 Jesus Said to them, "My mother and My brothers are these who hear the
Word of God and do it."

Matt 10:37-39

37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
38 And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me.

John 7:16 , 28-29, 37-39

16 Jesus answered them and Said, 'My Doctrine is not Mine, but His who Sent Me'
28 Then Jesus Cried out, as He taught in the temple, saying, "You both know Me, and you know where I Am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is True, whom you do not know.
29 But I know Him, for I Am from Him, and He Sent Me."
37 On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and Cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.
38 He who Believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of Living water."
39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet Glorified.

John 8:12, 18, 28-29

12 Jesus Spoke again, saying, "I Am the Light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the Light of Life."
18 I Am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who Sent Me bears witness of Me."
28 Then Jesus Said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I Am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father Taught Me, I Speak these things.
29 And He who Sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."

John 10:9, 11, 15, 17-18, 30, 38

9 I Am the Door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be Saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
11 "I Am the good Shepherd. The good Shepherd gives His Life for the sheep.
15 As the Father Knows Me, even so I Know the Father; and I lay down My Life for the sheep.
17 "Therefore My Father Loves Me, because I lay down My Life that I may take it again.
18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself.

I have Power to lay it down, and I have Power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."
30 I and My Father are one."
38 Believe the Works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him."

John 11:25-26, 41-42

25 Jesus Said to her, "I Am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall Live.
26 And whoever lives and Believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"
41 Jesus lifted up His eyes and Said, "Father, I thank You that You have Heard Me.
42 And I Know that You always Hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I Said this, that they may believe that You Sent Me."

Matt 17:2-3, 5

2 and He was Transfigured before them. His Face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.
3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.
5 While He was still Speaking, behold, a bright Cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a Voice came out of the Cloud, Saying, "This is My Beloved Son, in Whom I Am Well Pleased. Hear Him!"

Luke 19:41-42

41 As He drew near Jerusalem, He Saw the city and wept over it,
42 Saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.

John 2:15-17

15 When He had made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables.
16 And He Said to those who sold doves, "Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise!"
17 Then His disciples remembered that it was written, "Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up."

Matt 21:13

13 He Said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.' "

Matt 21:19, 21-22

19 Seeing a fig tree by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and Said to it, "Let no fruit grow on you ever again." Immediately the fig tree withered away.

21 So Jesus answered and Said to them, "Assuredly, I Say to you, if you have Faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done.

22 And whatever things you ask in prayer, Believing (Knowing), you will receive."

Matt 11:27

27 All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son Wills to Reveal Him.

Matt 16:27

27 The Son of Man will come in the Glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

Matthew 23:8, 10

8 You, do not be called 'Rabbi'; for One is your Teacher, the Christ, and you are all brethren.

10 And do not be called teachers; for One is your Teacher, the Christ.

Matthew 24:30-31, 35

30 The Sign of the Son of Man will appear in Heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the Clouds of Heaven with Power and great Glory.

31 And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of Heaven to the other.

35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My Words will by no means pass away.

Matthew 25:31-33

31 "When the Son of Man Comes in His Glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the Throne of His Glory.

32 All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats.

33 And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left.

John 12:44-47

44 Jesus Cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who Sent Me.

45 And he who sees Me sees Him who Sent Me.

46 I have come as a Light into the world, that whoever Believes in Me should not abide in darkness.

47 And if anyone hears My Words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to Save the world.

John 3:14-17

14 As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

15 that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have Eternal Life.

16 For God so Loved the world that He Gave His only begotten Son, that whoever Believes in Him should not perish but have Everlasting Life.

17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be Saved.

Matthew 20:28

28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His Life a ransom for many."

Matthew 12:40

40 As Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Luke 22:15

15 He Said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer;"

John 14:2, 6, 9, 20

2 "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you."

6 "I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

9 "He who has seen Me has seen the Father."

20 'At that day you will know that I Am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.'

John 15:5

5 'I Am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.'

John 16:28, 32

28 I Came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again, I Leave the world and Go to the Father."

32 Indeed the hour is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to his own, and will leave Me alone. And yet I Am not alone, because the Father is with Me.

John 17:1-5

1 Jesus Spoke these Words, lifted up His Eyes to Heaven, and Said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may Glorify You, 2 as You have given Him Authority over all flesh, that He should give Eternal Life to as many as You have given Him. 3 And this is Eternal Life, that they may know You, the only True God, and Jesus Christ whom You have Sent.

4 I have Glorified You on the earth. I have Finished the Work which You have given Me to Do.

5 And now, O Father, Glorify Me together with Yourself, with the Glory which I had with You before the world was.

6 "I have Manifested Your Name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your Word.

7 Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You.

8 For I have given to them the Words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You Sent Me.

9 I Pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.

10 And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I Am glorified in them.

11 Now I Am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your Name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.

12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your Name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

13 But now I come to You, and these things I Speak in the world, that they may have My Joy fulfilled in themselves.

14 I have given them Your Word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I Am not of the world.

15 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.

16 They are not of the world, just as I Am not of the world.

17 Sanctify them by Your Truth. Your Word is Truth.

18 As You Sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.

19 And for their sakes I Sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the Truth.

20 I do not Pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;

21 that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You Sent Me.

22 And the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:

23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have Sent Me, and have Loved them as You have Loved Me."

Luke 22:19-20

19 And He took bread, gave Thanks and Broke it, and gave it to them, Saying, "This is My Body which is Given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, Saying, "This cup is the new Covenant in My Blood, which is Shed for you.

Luke 22:69

69 Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the Power of God."

Mark 14:32, 34

32 Then they came to a place which was named Gethsemane;

34 Jesus Said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch."

Luke 22:42-44

41 And He knelt down and Prayed,

42 Saying, "Father, if it is Your Will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be Done."

43 Then an angel appeared to Him from Heaven, strengthening Him.

44 And being in agony, He Prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of Blood falling down to the ground.

Matt 26:42

42 Again, a second time, He went away and Prayed, Saying, "O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me unless I Drink it, Your Will be Done."

John 18:36

36 Jesus Answered, 'My Kingdom is not of this world.

36 If My Kingdom were of this world, My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now My Kingdom is not from here.'

Matt 27:28-31, 37, 45-46

28 They stripped Lord Jesus and put a scarlet robe on Him.
29 When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His Head, and a reed in His right Hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"
30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the Head.
31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.
32 Now as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name. Him they compelled to bear His cross.
33 And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, that is to say, place of a skull,
34 they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink.
35 Then they crucified Him, and divided His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: "They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots."
37 And they put up over His Head the accusation written against Him: THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
45 Now from the sixth hour until the ninth hour there was darkness over all the land.
46 And about the ninth hour Jesus Cried out with a loud Voice, Saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

John 19:28

28 After this, Jesus, Knowing that all things were now Accomplished, that the Scripture might be Fulfilled, Said, "I Thirst!"

John 19:30

30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He Said, "It Is Finished!" And bowing His Head, He Gave up His Spirit.

Luke 23:46

46 And when Jesus had Cried out with a loud Voice, He Said, "Father, 'into Your Hands I commit My Spirit.' Having Said this, He Breathed His last.

Matt 27:51-53, 59-60

51 Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split,
52 and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised;
53 and coming out of the graves after His Resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many.
59 When Joseph of Arimathea had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,
60 and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.

Matt 28:2-3, 5-6

2 And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from Heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door of the tomb, and sat on it.
3 His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow.

Luke 24:5-7

4 And it happened that two men stood by them in shining garments.
5 They said to them, "Why do you seek the Living among the dead?
6 He is not here, but is Risen! Remember how He Spoke to you when He was still in Galilee,

17 Jesus Said to Mary, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I Am Ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.'"
26 After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and Said, "Peace to you!"
27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My Hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but Believing."
28 And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
29 Jesus Said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have Believed."

39 Behold My Hands and My Feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have."
40 When He had Said this, He showed them His Hands and His Feet.

11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into Heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into Heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into Heaven."

Revelation 1:13-16

13 in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band.
14 His Head and Hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His Eyes like a flame of fire;
15 His Feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His Voice as the sound of many waters;
16 He had in His right Hand seven stars, out of His Mouth went a sharp two-edged Sword, and His Countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.

13 And every creature which is in Heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and Honor and Glory and Power be to Him who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!"

14 Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who Lives forever and ever.

Revelation 7:9-10

9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the Throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the Throne, and to the Lamb!"

Revelation 14:14-16

14 Then I looked, and behold, a white Cloud, and on the Cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His Head a golden crown, and in His Hand a sharp sickle.

15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the Cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe."

16 So He who sat on the Cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.

Revelation 19:11-16

11 Now I saw Heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in Righteousness He Judges and makes war.

12 His Eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His Head were many crowns. He had a Name written that no one knew except Himself.

13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in Blood, and His name is called the Word of God.

14 And the armies in Heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.

15 Now out of His Mouth goes a sharp Sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And He has on His Robe and on His Thigh a Name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Revelation 21:6-7, 23

6 And He Said to me, "It is Done! I Am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will Give of the fountain of the water of Life freely to him who thirsts.

7 He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.

23 The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the Glory of God illuminated it.

The Lamb is its Light.

Revelation 22:1-6, 12-13, 16-17

1 And he showed me a pure river of water of Life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the Throne of God and of the Lamb.

2 In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of Life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the Healing of the nations.

3 And there shall be no more curse, but the Throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.

4 They shall see His Face, and His Name shall be on their foreheads.

5 There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them Light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

6 Then he said to me, "These Words are Faithful and True." And the Lord God of the holy prophets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place.

12 "Behold, I Am coming quickly, and My Reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.

13 I Am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."

16 "I, Jesus, have Sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I Am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star."

17 And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of Life FREELY.
