Luke 1:5-9, 11-20

5 There was a certain priest named Zacharias, of the division of Abijah. His wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth.

6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the Commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.

7 But they had no child, because Elizabeth was barren, and they were both well advanced in years.

8 So it was, that while he was serving as priest before God in the order of his division,

9 according to the custom of the priesthood, his lot fell to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord.

11 Then an angel of the Lord Appeared to him, standing on the right side of the altar of incense.

12 And when Zacharias saw him, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him.

13 But the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.

14 And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.

15 For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother’s womb.

16 And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God.

17 He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, ‘to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,’ and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.”

18 And Zacharias said to the angel, “How shall I know this? For I am an old man, and my wife is well advanced in years.”

19 And the angel answered and said to him, “I am Gabriel, who stands in the Presence of God, and was Sent to speak to you and bring you these glad tidings.

20 But behold, you will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my Words which will be fulfilled in their own time.”

Luke 1:59, 62-64, 67-79

59 On the eighth day, they came to circumcise the child;

62 So they made signs to his father—what he would have him called.

63 And he asked for a writing tablet, and wrote, saying, “His name is John.”

64 Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue loosed, and he spoke, praising God.

67 Now Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit, and prophesied, saying:

68 “Blessed is the Lord God of Israel, for He has visited and Redeemed His people,

69 And has raised up a horn of Salvation for us in the house of His servant David,

70 As He Spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets, who have been since the world began,

71 That we should be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us,

72 To perform the mercy promised to our fathers and to remember His Holy Covenant,

73 The oath which He swore to our father Abraham:

74 To grant us that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve Him without fear,

75 In holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of our life.

76 “And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Highest; for you will go before the Face of the Lord to prepare His Ways,

77 To give knowledge of salvation to His people by the remission of their sins,

78 Through the tender Mercy of our God, with which the dayspring from on high has visited us;

79 To give Light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of Peace.”

2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

3 Jesus answered and Said to him, "Most assuredly, I Say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God."

4 Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old?

Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"

5 Jesus Answered, "Most assuredly, I Say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God.

6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is Spirit.

7 Do not marvel that I Said to you, 'You must be born again.'

8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes.

So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

9 Nicodemus answered and said to Him, "How can these things be?"

10 Jesus answered and Said to him, "Are you the teacher of Israel, and do not know these things?

11 Most assuredly, I Say to you, We Speak what We Know and Testify what We have Seen, and you do not receive Our Witness.

12 If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you Heavenly things?

13 No one has ascended to Heaven but He who came down from Heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in Heaven.

14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

15 that whoever Believes in Him should not perish but have eternal Life.

16 For God so Loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever Believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting Life.

17 For God did not Send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be Saved.

18 "He who Believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the Name of the only begotten Son of God.

19 And this is the condemnation, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than Light, because their deeds were evil.

20 For everyone practicing evil hates the Light and does not come to the Light, lest his deeds should be exposed.

21 But he who does the Truth comes to the Light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God."

50 Nicodemus (he who came to Jesus by night, being one of them) said to them,

51 "Does our law judge a man before it hears him and knows what he is doing?"

John 19:39-42

39 And Nicodemus, who at first came to Jesus by night, also came, bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about a hundred pounds.

40 Then they took the Body of Jesus, and bound it in strips of linen with the spices, as the custom of the Jews is to bury.

41 Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid.

42 So there they laid Jesus, because of the Jews' Preparation Day, for the tomb was nearby.

5 As long as I Am in the world, I Am the Light of the world."

6 When He had Said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He Anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay.

7 And He Said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.

17 They said to the blind man, "What do you say about Him because He opened your eyes?" He said, "He is a prophet.

25 Whether He is a sinner or not I do not know.

One thing I know: that though I was blind, now I see,

30 this is a marvelous thing, that you do not know where He is from; yet He has opened my eyes!

31 Now we know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshiper of God and does His will, He Hears him.

32 Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind.

33 If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing."

35 Jesus Heard that they had cast him out; and when He had Found him,
