- 27 to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary.
- 28 And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; Blessed are you among women!"
- 29 But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was.
- 30 Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found Favor with God.
- 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His Name Jesus.
- 32 He will be Great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will Give Him the throne of His father David.
- 33 And He will Reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His Kingdom there will be no end."
- 34 Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"
- 35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the Power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One Who is to be born will be called the Son of God.
- 36 Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren.
- 37 For with God nothing will be impossible."

- 9 Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.
- 10 Jesus answered and Said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and Who it is Who Says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you Living water."
- 11 The woman said to Him, "Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that Living water?
- 12 Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?"

- 4 But when they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away--for it was very large.
- 5 And entering the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed.
- 6 But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, Who was crucified. He is Risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him.
- 7 And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is Risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He Said to you."

Luke 24:5-10

- 5 As the women were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, the angels said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?
- 6 He is not here, but is Risen! Remember how He Spoke to you when He was still in Galilee,

- 8 And they remembered His Words.

- 9 "Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there. See, I have Commanded a widow there to provide for you."
- 12 She said to Elijah, "As the Lord your God Lives, I do not have bread, only a handful of flour in a bin, and a little oil in a jar; and see, I am gathering a couple of sticks that I may go in and prepare it for myself and my son, that we may eat it, and die."
- 13 And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said, but make me a small cake from it first, and bring it to me; and afterward make some for yourself and your son.
- 14 For thus Says the Lord God of Israel: 'The bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, until the day the Lord Sends rain on the earth.' "
- 15 So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and he and her household ate for many days.

- 16 The bin of flour was not used up, nor did the jar of oil run dry, according to the Word of the Lord which He Spoke by Elijah.
- 17 Now it happened after these things that the son of the woman who owned the house became sick. And his sickness was so serious that there was no breath left in him.
- 18 So she said to Elijah, "What have I to do with you, O man of God? Have you come to me to bring my sin to remembrance, and to kill my son?"
- 19 And he said to her, "Give me your son."
- 20 Then he cried out to the Lord and said, "O Lord my God, have You also brought tragedy on the widow with whom I lodge, by killing her son?"
- 22 Then the Lord Heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came back to him, and he Revived.
- 24 Then the woman said to Elijah, "Now by this I know that you are a man of God, and that the Word of the Lord in your mouth is the Truth."

- 1 A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets cried out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the Lord. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves."
- 2 So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil."
- 3 Then he said, "Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors--empty vessels; do not gather just a few.
- 4 And when you have come in, you shall shut the door behind you and your sons; then pour it into all those vessels, and set aside the full ones."
- 5 So she went from him and shut the door behind her and her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she poured it out.
- 6 Now it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said to her son, "Bring me another vessel." And he said to her, "There is not another vessel." So the oil ceased.

8 Now it happened one day that Elisha went to Shunem, where there was a notable woman, and she persuaded him to eat some food. So it was, as often as he passed by, he would turn in there to eat some food.

- 9 And she said to her husband, "Look now, I know that this is a holy man of God, who passes by us regularly.
- 10 Please, let us make a small upper room on the wall; and let us put a bed for him there, and a table and a chair and a lampstand; so it will be, whenever he comes to us, he can turn in there."
- 11 And it happened one day that he came there, and he turned in to the upper room and lay down there.
- 13 And he said to Gehazi, "Say now to her, 'Look, you have been concerned for us with all this care. What can I do for you? Do you want me to speak on
- your behalf to the king or to the commander of the army?" She answered, "I dwell among my own people."
- 16 Then Elisha said, "About this time next year you shall embrace a son." And she said, "No, my lord. Man of God, do not lie to your maidservant!"
- 17 But the woman conceived, and bore a son when the appointed time had come, of which Elisha had told her.
- 18 And the child grew. Now it happened one day that he went out to his father, to the reapers.
- 19 And he said to his father, "My head, my head!" So he said to a servant, "Carry him to his mother."
- 20 The child sat on her knees till noon, and then died.
- 21 And she went up and laid him on the bed of the man of God, shut the door upon him, and went out.
- 27 When she came to the man of God at the hill, she caught him by the feet. The man of God said to Gehazi, "Let her alone; for her soul is in deep distress, and the Lord has hidden it from me, and has not told me."
- 28 So she said, "Did I ask a son of my lord? Did I not say, 'Do not deceive me'?"
- 30 And the mother of the child said, "As the Lord Lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." So he arose and followed her.
- 32 When Elisha came into the house, there was the child, lying dead on his bed.
- 33 He went in therefore, shut the door behind the two of them, and prayed to the Lord.
- 35 then the child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eyes.

2 Kings 8:1-3, 5-6

- 1 Then Elisha spoke to the woman whose son he had restored to life, saying, "Arise and go, you and your household, and stay wherever you can; for the Lord has Called for a famine, and furthermore, it will come upon the land for seven years."
- 2 So the woman arose and did according to the saying of the man of God, and she went with her household and dwelt in the land of the Philistines seven years.
- 3 It came to pass, at the end of seven years, that the woman returned from the land of the Philistines; and she went to make an appeal to the king for her house and for her land.
- 5 Now it happened, as Elisha's servant was telling the king how he had restored the dead to life, that there was the woman whose son he had restored to life, appealing to the king for her house and for her land. And Gehazi said, "My lord, O king, this is the woman, and this is her son whom Elisha restored to life."
- 6 And when the king asked the woman, she told him. So the king appointed a certain officer for her, saying, "Restore all that was hers, and all the proceeds of the field from the day that she left the land until now."
