

Lesson 11 – Sounding a bass on your guitar.

- When you play the chord of E, all 6 strings, you play both bare E strings, the high E string and the low E string.
- When you play the chord of G, all 6 strings, you play in fact the note **g** on the lowest string, the note **g** on the highest string and the bare G string (third string).

Let's look at the G chord:



- The g on the low e-string is your lowest sounding tone in the chord.
 And at the same time the g is the most important note in the chord of G.
 Both these facts make this tone very important and you can use the low g as a bass in the chord of G.
- First learn the song 'I am Redeemed', see below:
- With the examples on the next page, the song is written out in measures and shows
 the strumming using a bass represented by a bullet for a single string and a down
 arrow for strumming the rest of the strings.
- Clap the beat while you are humming the song. Clap the beat according to example 1 and clap according to example 2. Example 2 has twice as many claps for each word.






• **Strumming the guitar**: This concept of the bass (lowest string) in the chord you can use as follows:

First example: Play string number 6 represented by • under the word, on beat 1 and 3 (the heavier beats). String 6 is the low note **g** and **bass** to this song,

On beat number 2 and number 4 you strum the other strings represented by \$\diamslep\$

Second example: You play the bass string on every beat and you strum the other strings in between each beat. Your right hand moves twice as fast while your singing remains the same.

Next is the song 'I have the joy' written out in measures:

- Clap the beat while you are humming the song.
- **Strumming the guitar:** Use the same strum pattern as in the first song: Play only string number 6 on every first beat and every third beat (the heavier beats), and on the second beat and fourth beat you strum the other strings.
